An athlete's final score is obtained by adding the four best scores in the Dextro Energy Triathlon - ITU World Championship Series events and the ITU Triathlon World Cup events, plus

the points gained in the Dextro Energy Triathlon - ITU World Championships Grand Final. A maximum of two ITU Triathlon World Cup events scores will count for the final rankings. The Dextro Energy Triathlon - ITU World Championship Rankings are the first priority list to determine the eligible athletes for the Dextro Energy Triathlon - ITU World Championship Grand Final, the Dextro Energy Triathlon - ITU World Championship Series events and the ITU Triathlon World Cup events.
